## Maths

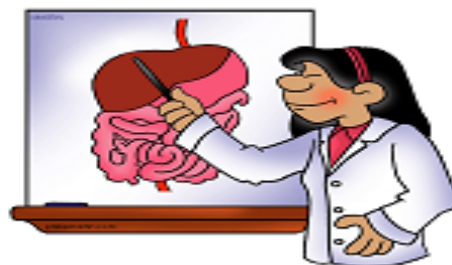
- Decimals, percentages and their equivalence to fractions.

### Teeth and Digestion

- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
  - Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
- Describe how teeth and gums have to be cared for in order to keep them healthy.
- Compare the teeth of carnivores and herbivores.
  - Suggest reasons for differences.
- Investigate what damages teeth and how to look after them.
- Draw and discuss ideas about the digestive system and compare them with models or images.
