Key Vocabulary

Liturgical Calendar: a cycle of seasons in the church year that determines when feasts are celebrated and particular readings are shared.

Seasons: the liturgical year is divided into different seasons. Each season has distinctive music and specific readings, prayers, rituals, and colours.

Journey: a trip from one place to another.

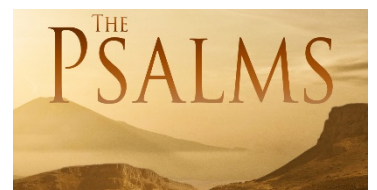
Ordinary Time: the part of the Church's year that falls outside the major seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter.

Feast day: a special day to celebrate a particular saint or religious event.

Our Lady: a special title given to Mary the mother of Jesus.

Rosary: a form of prayer that uses beads.

Liturgy: a form of worship which includes proclaiming the Gospel.
