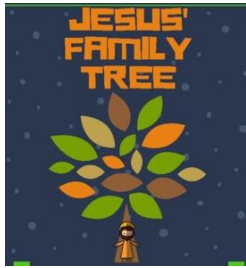
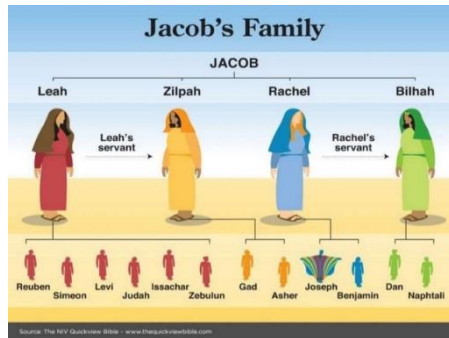

People

In this unit we will learn that Jesus had a human family like ours. Abraham was the first person mentioned in Jesus' family tree. God chose him to be the Father of His chosen people. We will learn about Jacob, Ruth and Solomon all key people in the Old Testament. We will think about Joseph's role in Jesus' life.



Key Vocabulary

Chosen people: the Jewish people as being chosen by God to have a special relationship with Him.

Siblings: a brother or a sister.

Ancestors: a person related to you who lived a long time ago.

Generations: the people in a family born and living during the same time.

Old Testament: The first part of the Bible containing 39 books comprising the law, history, wisdom and prophecy of the ancient people of Israel.

Genealogy: a line of descent traced continuously from an ancestor.

Nomad: a person who has no fixed place to live and moves from one place to another rather than live in one place.
