Key Vocabulary

Gaudete Sunday: The third Sunday of Advent.

Gaudete: the Latin word for rejoice.

Messiah: the one promised by God who would show God's love and bring peace.

Loyalty: faithfulness and allegiance to a person or an idea.

Commitment: a promise to do or give something.

Peace: a time without fights or wars. A state of quiet or calm that is not disturbed by anything at all.
