Key Vocabulary

Rosary: The word "Rosary" means a chain of roses and the roses are prayers. The Rosary Prayer tells us about the life of Jesus and his Mother, Mary.

Glorious Mysteries: The Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary are the final events in the life of Christ and His Blessed Mother, Mary.

- 2. The Ascension of Jesus into Heaven.
- 3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.
- 4. The Assumption of Mary into Heaven.
- 5. The Coronation of Our Lady in Heaven.

Pentecost: the descent of the Holy Spirit on the disciples of Jesus after his Ascension, held on the seventh Sunday after Easter.
