Key Vocabulary

Rule: something we have to try to follow.

New start: to begin again.

Friend: someone who you like and know and enjoy being with.

Forgive: to stop feeling upset with someone who has done something wrong.

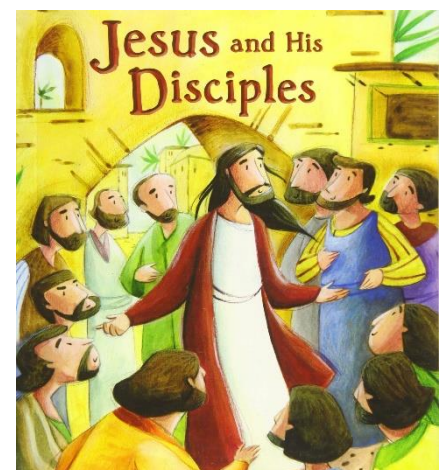
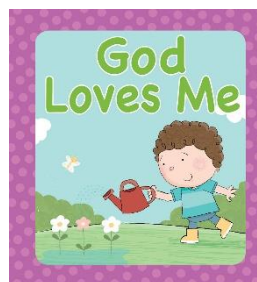
Change: to do something differently.
