Key vocabulary	Definition
Criteria	A standard by which something can be judged.
Audience	The person who watches it or sees it.
Non-linear	Not in a straight line. Moving about rather than in just one direction.
Consistency	The same. Not changing much.
Font	A style of text. Like this. Like this. LIKE THIS. like this.
Image	A picture or photograph.
Hyperlink	A link activated by clicking on text or an image.
Plagiarism	Taking somebody else's work and pretending it is yours.
Copyright	The person who created the work decides what happens with it. 70 years after the creator dies, copyright ends.
Creative Commons	A way for creators to say that anybody can use that content.

Use hyperlinks to produce more interactive, non-linear presentations.


Understand the potential of multimedia to inform or persuade.

Use images to enhance presentations.


