Animation	A series of images played quickly one after another to give the illusion of movement.
Frame	One image in an animation.
Onion Skinning	A technique where the previous frame can be faintly seen to allow for accurate drawing on the next frame.
Background	A still image behind the animated parts that can be used in many frames.
Storyboard	A series of quick and simple sketches to show the idea of the story.
