Satellite map	A view taken from a satellite. Looking down on the planet as if one large photograph.
3D	Shows areas that have been scanned as a 3D model.
Location Pin 	Shows the location of a place searched for.
Street View 	A series of stitched photographs to give the effect of walking or driving down a road.

Key Knowledge and Learning:

- Be able to compare digital maps with paper maps.
- Be able to search, scroll and zoom a digital map.
- Be able to find information about a route from Kirkham to Edinburgh.
- Know that a route can be calculated for walking or driving in a car.
- Change a route by dragging the points on the map.
- Create a walking route from A to B that goes past C.
- Use 3D view to explore a city.
- Use street view to get a more accurate picture of what places in Edinburgh are like.
- Use digital mapping to plan days out around Edinburgh.
