What is this topic?

In this topic we will be looking at a range of materials, tools and techniques beginning with dip dye materials. This topic includes creating printing blocks, exploring the use of these printing blocks on a range of material surfaces. This topic also looks at card wrapping and investigating different materials.

Key Vocabulary

Fabric	Cloth or other material produced by weaving or knitting fibres.
Material	The matter from which a thing is or can be made.
Dip dye	Cover fabric in a solution to colour it.
Relief block	Carving patterns or designs into a block.
