Year 6 P.E.

<u>Autumn 1 - WW1 Dance</u>



Overview

In this topic, Year 6 children will link their P.E. unit of dance, focussing on creative movements, freeze frames and transitions, to their history topic of World War One. The children will work independently and as part of a group to re-enact several scenes and scenarios from trench life as freeze frames. The children work on body language to convey emotion, the transition between freeze frames and working creatively as a group.

Key knowledge - P.E

- I can create independent freeze frames to convey scenes from WW1 trench life.
- I can use body language and facial expressions to convey emotion and communicate feeling.
- I can create a sequence of freeze frames based on WW1 trench life scenarios, working on different levels.
- I can incorporate creative turns and movements between freeze frames to create smooth transitions.
- I can work with others to plan, practice and perform a sequence of freeze frames based on WW1 scenarios.
- I can self-evaluate my freeze frame sequence and can provide constructive feedback for others on their performances based on agreed success criteria.

<u>Character skills developed in</u> this <u>unit:</u>

- Resilience and perseverance Working independently to create a sequence of freeze frames. Not giving up, adapting sequence based on feed back and improving work.
- Respect and team work Working effectively with others to create a sequence, listening to the ideas of others in a group and working together to improve work.

Emotion/Feelings

This is part of the performance of the dance. Emotion is used to communicate the feeling and the characters of the dance to the audience. A

way to do this is with the dynamics of the movements as it can demonstrate power, enjoyment, curiosity etc.



Self Analysis

This is being able to discover strengths and areas for improvement in your dance, then modify and improve. Doing this through video is hugely beneficial as you are able to see things for yourself such as timings, the emotion of the performance, if a move works or not, levels
