Year 5 French: Summer 1 Out of this world



This half term is really useful for Stage 3 learners to recap lots of prior knowledge in a new context.

The children will start by recapping personal information as they read and create alien ID cards for the alien space travellers, and take part in space traveller question and answer conversations.

The children go on to learn the names of planets in French, follow a bilingual story about the moon, then proceed to create their own planets and describe them using prior knowledge such as colours, fruits, places in a town and animals.

Through songs, games, video clips and independent tasks, they will explore the following content, topics and language:

1) Out of this world

- Personal information through the theme of alien space traveller ID cards
- Question and answer session personal information
- Bilingual story take me to the moon
- Learn names for planets in our solar system in French
- Read information about planets
- Create own planet with name and description of what is on their planet

Learning Objective for each lesson:

- I can understand words used on an ID card
- I can ask and answer questions about someone's identity
- I can read simple information about planets
- I can read and understand simple information about planets
- 5) I can create simple sentences about an imaginary planet
- 6) I can make a poster about my planet creation


