# Year 6 French: Spring 1 Playing and enjoying sport

#### In this module:

This half term the children will start with a special performance lesson of a New Year's Rap. The children then explore the topic of sports. They will learn the nouns for sports, and look at the verb 'jouer' and the sports connected to this verb. Then, the children will create opinions about sports and look at a variety of adjectives in order to include reasons for liking or disliking a sport. The children will follow the story of the aliens at the Olympics, and will have a cultural lesson about the French sport 'boules', look inside an authentic French sports shop and write a description of a sport and how it is played.

Through games, native speaker clips, a story and independent tasks, they will explore the following content, topics and language:

### 1a) Happy New Year

- Listen to and enjoy a rap about new year in French
- Identify and read familiar language
- Optional join in a performance, look at happy new year in other languages

#### 1b) Sports

- Look at nouns for sports
- Look at the verb 'to play'
- Create extended opinions about sports (including reasons)
- Read and understand information about sports
- Write a description of a sport
